- * TIME & PLACE The class meets every Sunday from 10:00-11:10 am in the Reeb Room of the Fahs House (downstairs, the middle room closest to the back parking lot). This is earlier than Middle Hour typically starts. Be sure to bring your child on time at 10am.
- * **FOOD** Please do not send kids with food. They should eat before they come... If you attend the 9am service we encourage the kids to get coffee hour snacks before coming to BB.
- * ATTENDANCE Regular attendance is crucial for kids to get the information they need, and to support the goals of this program. Sporadic attendance means the whole group suffers in their ability to bond. Please make this program a priority in your child's schedule.
- * **REGISTRATION** Please be sure your child is registered for R.E. or s/he will not be on the attendance sheet, nor will your contact information be part of Rev. Christina's communications' list. To register, go to **tinyurl.com/UUCARE1617**. Also, complete the "All Inclusive Permission Form" (attached) for this specific class.
- * E-MAIL Rev. Christina & her volunteer assistant Rob Wallace will communicate with facilitators and parents regularly to remind about upcoming visits, request parent assistance for Sunday classes and/or chaperone site visits, or alert you to changes in the schedule. Schedule changes are often the result of issues with the site we are planning to visit, and these issues are beyond our control. Please be patient and flexible, and check your e-mail regularly!

Sundays, September 11 and 18 - Ingathering / First RE Sunday -

On September 11 at 10:00am we will have our final summer service and our annual "Ingathering" and Water Communion followed by a community potluck picnic.
