

POLICY ON SOLICITING, SELLING AND PROMOTION OF MERCHANDISE AND SERVICES AT CHURCH

The Unitarian Universalist Church of Annapolis limits the selling of items or services at church for personal profit or for the benefit of any group not part of an organization with the church. Such selling shall be permitted only in one of the following circumstances:

- In conjunction with approved UUCA fundraising events or budget income lines approved by the Executive Team

Promotion of personal businesses at church will be limited to the display of business cards or materials on the church's community bulletin board. This policy is not intended to discourage networking among members, only the explicit advertising, promotion, or sales of services or products. Further, UUCA church members shall not use the church membership lists or names in the church directory for personal gain, advertising or solicitation for personal businesses or personal use.

Solicitation of donations will be limited to efforts specifically in line with UUCA's 8 principles, and will take place only on the designated table in the narthex in back of the coat racks.

Individuals may give to the church administrator a business card or material to be placed on the bulletin board. Individuals wanting to display materials or solicitations for causes in line with 8 principle practices on the narthex table should check with the church office for consideration.
